

**INVITATION TO BID

Notice is hereby given that the City of Kalama will receive sealed bids at the Kalama City Hall, 195 North First Street, Kalama, Washington, 98625 until 10:00 a.m., March 19, 2019, for the following work: CLOVERDALE BOOSTER PUMP STATION.

Work performed under this contract consists of the following:

Providing all materials and labor to construct approximately 700 linear feet of 4-inch PVC and DI water main piping and associated appurtenances, 40 linear feet of 18-inch HDPE storm piping, package booster pump station, a standby generator, and associated appurtenances, gravel access road, pump station building, and restoration as shown on the drawings.

All Bids must be submitted on the regular bid form furnished within the specifications, and each must be accompanied by a certified check or bidder's bond in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total bid. The successful Bidder will be required to furnish the necessary additional bond(s) for the faithful performance of the work, as prescribed in the bidding documents. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory payment and performance bond within the time stated in specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited.

In order to perform public work, the successful Bidder and Subcontractors, shall hold or obtain such licenses and registrations as required by Washington State Statutes and Codes, and federal and local Laws and Regulations. All work performed on this project shall be subject to the Washington State Prevailing Wage Rates.

The City of Kalama reserves the right to reject any and all Bids and waive any informality in the bids.
